

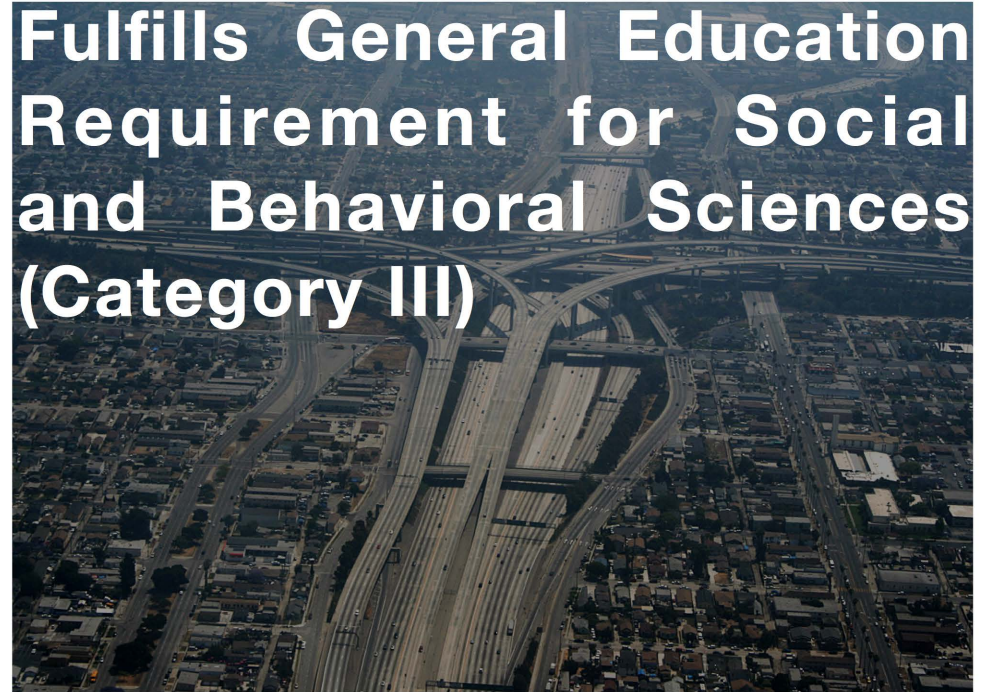

We will analyze historic and contemporary urban issues throughout the U.S. during the first six weeks, and then focus on Southern California in the last four weeks. Using case studies from Orange County and Los Angeles County, we will explore how local governments grapple with challenges of sustainability and social justice.
